

## PosterSessionOnline for ESUI 2017

We are proud to present once again the innovative [PosterSessionOnline](#) service PosterSessionOnline for the **6th Meeting of the EAU Section of Urological Imaging (ESUI)**, a high-quality, subsidized **printing & delivery service** which is available to all poster presenters.

The PosterSessionOnline Service will print your poster which you can collect at the congress venue (price per poster € 59 excl. 21% VAT). This way you do not need to bring your poster to Barcelona!

To benefit from this service, presenters should:

### STEP 1: Prepare your poster in PowerPoint or PDF, 90 x 120 cm portrait (vertical), 1 slide only

- Follow our comprehensive [poster design course](#) for PowerPoint.
- View the [editing and layout guidelines](#) (recommended font sizes, etc).

### STEP 2: Submit your poster file online

- a) Click to [start the submission process](#).
- b) Enter the first author's name then find your poster details.
- c) When you have submitted your poster correctly, you will receive an email confirmation.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What is the cost of the service?

- The **PrintingOnline and delivery** service costs **59€ + 21% VAT = 71.39€**
- Collect it on-site at the Registration Desk.


What is the production quality of the poster produced?

- The poster is available with 4 colour printing on 200g/m<sup>2</sup> photographic paper.
- Poster size **90 x 120 cm portrait (vertical)**.


When is the deadline?

- The deadline for submitting a poster is **7th November 2017 at 23:59 (GMT+1)**.

### Correct dimensions




A common mistake in posters we receive is incorrect dimensions. This can cause distortion to the final format for printing.



These are the correct poster dimensions:

90 cm (width) x 120 cm (height)

Please set up your poster correctly in PowerPoint: **<Design> <Page Set-up>**  
This avoids us having to ask you to resend your poster.
